Petition for Action on Conditions of Pretrial Release

COMES NOW, PRETRIAL SERVICES OFFICER, Mark Quarles, presenting an official report upon the conduct of defendant, Paul S. Minor, who was placed under pretrial release supervision by the Honorable James C. Sumner sitting in the Court at Jackson, on August 6, 2003, under the following conditions and these bond conditions remained in force in hearings before the Honorable Henry T. Wingate, Chief United States District Judge, with the last orders being filed on August 17, 2006 and August 24, 2006.

- (12) The defendant shall participate in the Home Confinement Program at his residence in Baton Rouge, Louisiana pending trial. During this time, the defendant shall remain at his place of residence at all times. Exceptions may include activities approved in advance by his probation officer who will submit the requests to the Court and the Court will make the final determination as to any leaves the defendant may be granted.

Respectfully presenting petition for action of Court and for cause as follows:

On August 24, 2006, the defendant's electronic monitoring equipment indicated that he was out of range from 1:33 p.m. to 2:23 p.m. When questioned about his being out of range, the defendant advised he was out jogging when it began to rain and an elderly neighbor offered him a ride home. The defendant contends that he was not out of range. Additionally, on September 5, 2006, the electronic monitoring equipment indicated the defendant was out of range from 11:48 a.m. to 4:01 p.m. without the approval of the court.

PRAYING THAT THE COURT WILL ORDER a WARRANT be issued for the defendant's arrest and a hearing held to determine if he has violated his conditions of pretrial release.
